AFFIDAVIT

- I, Paula Render, of the City of Chicago, in the State of Illinois, MAKE OATH AND SAY:
- I am a Partner at the law firm of Jones Day, antitrust lawyers for the Arctic Glacier Parties. I am one of the lawyers representing the Arctic Glacier Parties in Martin McNulty's litigation against the Arctic Glacier Parties, amongst others, filed in the Michigan Court (the "Michigan Action"), and, as such, I have knowledge of the matters contained in this affidavit. Where my knowledge is based on information and belief, I indicate the source of the information and verily believe it to be true.
- 2. I have been advised by Jeremy Dacks, of the law firm Osler, Hoskin & Harcourt LLP, counsel for the Monitor in these proceedings, and believe that McNulty filed a Proof of Claim in these CCAA Proceedings based on the Michigan Action (the

"McNulty Claim"). McNulty's counsel includes Mr. Kotchen and Mr. Low, of the firm Kotchen & Low LLP, located in Washington, D.C.

- 3. As early as January 2013, I spoke with Mr. Low to advise that the Monitor intended to dispute the McNulty Claim and would like to talk about the process going forward.
- 4. In August 2013, I spoke by telephone with Mr. Kotchen and Mr. Low regarding the McNulty Claim. Either Mr. Kotchen or Mr. Low noted that a U.S. claims adjudicator had been appointed to hear the Indirect Purchaser Claim, and asked if a U.S. claims adjudicator could be similarly appointed for the McNulty Claim.
- 5. I told Mr. Kotchen and Mr. Low that Arctic Glacier might be amenable to the use of a U.S claims adjudicator instead of a Canadian claims officer, but that I would have to discuss it with Arctic Glacier. I also told Mr. Kotchen and Mr. Low that the decision was not one I could make, but would have to be made by the Monitor. I told them that if they wanted to pursue the concept of the use of a U.S. claims adjudicator further, they would need to discuss it with the Monitor.
- On December 3, 2013, McNulty's Counsel wrote to Claims Officer Ground asking him not to hear the McNulty Claim on the basis, among other reasons, that the McNulty Claim should be resolved in the United States by an adjudicator familiar with the applicable U.S. law. McNulty's counsel also stated that I had said that the Arctic Glacier Parties would be amenable to choosing a claims adjudicator based in the United States. A copy of McNulty's counsel's December 3, 2013 letter is attached to the Monitor's Eighteenth Report.

7. On December 3, 2013, I wrote to McNulty's counsel and objected to the

characterization of our conversation, stating:

I object to your referring...to only part of our conversation about the appointment of a claims officer. I told you that Arctic Glacier might be amenable, but that I did not know the Canadian process and that it was not my decision to make. Please make the correction at your first opportunity.

A copy of my December 3, 2013, email is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

8. I am not aware of McNulty's counsel correcting the record, nor did I

receive a response from McNulty's counsel to my December 3, 2013, email.

9. Finally, I do not believe, and have never believed, that I had or have the

authority to agree to the use of a U.S. claims adjudicator for the McNulty Claim. I have

been representing the Arctic Glacier Parties in litigation brought in the U.S. As part of

that representation, I participated in the resolution of the Indirect Purchaser Claim. At the

time of my discussion with Mr. Kotchen and Mr. Low, my understanding, through my

work on the Indirect Purchaser Claim, was that it was not up to me or Arctic Glacier to

make such a decision.
