Transactions subject to review by the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS) are facing greater levels of scrutiny and more indepth analyses of their potential national security impacts than ever before.

To be successful in obtaining CFIUS clearance, transactional parties and their advisors must thoroughly understand the potential threats posed by a foreign acquirer or its host nation, the vulnerabilities of the U.S. target company's sensitive assets or operations to foreign access and control, and the various methods by which such threats and vulnerabilities can be adequately assessed, mitigated, and monitored to the satisfaction of the CFIUS review teams.


