- 1. On June 21, 2012, the Honourable Mr. Justice Grauer pronounced an Initial Order in these proceedings pursuant to the provisions of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended, which granted relief, including, *inter alia*, a stay of proceedings until 11:59 p.m. on July 20, 2012.
- 2. On July 20, 2012, the Petitioners applied for, and were granted, an extension of the relief in the Initial Order, including the stay of proceedings, to September 28, 2012.
- 3. On September 7, 2012, October 3, 2012, October 19, 2012, October 26, 2012, November 28, 2012, February 13, 2013, May 28, 2013 and August 30, 2013 (the "Ninth Extension Order"), the Petitioners applied for, and were granted, further extensions of the relief in the Initial Order including the stay of proceedings.

- 4. The relief granted in the Ninth Extension Order expires on September 3, 2013. Accordingly, the Petitioners seek an extension of the Initial Order to December 20, 2013.
