TAKE NOTICE than an application will be made by the applicants before the Honourable Mr. Justice Grauer at the Courthouse at 800 Smithe Street, Vancouver, BC, V6Z 2E1 on Friday, the 25th day of July, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. for the Orders set out in Part 1 below.

Part 1: ORDER(S) SOUGHT

- 1. An Order to extend the CCAA stay until November 30, 2014, all in the form of Order attached hereto as Schedule "B".
- 2. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may order.

Part 2: FACTUAL BASIS

1. On June 21, 2012, the Honourable Mr. Justice Grauer pronounced an Initial Order in these proceedings pursuant to the provisions of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement*

- Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended, which granted relief, including, inter alia, a stay of proceedings until 11:59 p.m. on July 20, 2012.
- 2. On July 20, 2012, the Petitioners applied for, and were granted, an extension of the relief in the Initial Order, including the stay of proceedings, to September 28, 2012.
- 3. On September 7, 2012, October 3, 2012, October 19, 2012, October 26, 2012, November 28, 2012, February 13, 2013, May 28, 2013, August 30, 2013, September 3, 2013, December 17, 2013 and March 9, 2014, the Petitioners applied for, and were granted, further extensions of the relief in the Initial Order including the stay of proceedings.
- 4. The relief granted including the stay or proceedings expires on July 31, 2014. Accordingly, the Petitioners seek an extension of the Initial Order to May 16, 2014.
- 5. The Petitioners have been and continue to act in good faith and with due diligence in these proceedings.
- 6. The Petitioners held a meeting of the Trade Creditors on July 8, 2014 to vote on the Plan.
- 7. The Plan was approved by the creditors.
- 8. Concentra Financial Services Association has obtain leave to appeal the Meeting Order and the appeal is scheduled to be heard on August 14, 2014.

- 1. Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended, and in particular ss. 11, 11.02 and 19 thereof; and
- 2. The inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court.
