The Applicants will make a motion before the Honourable Madam Justice Spivak on Tuesday, April 3, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. or as soon after that time as the motion can be heard, at the Law Courts Building, 408 York Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

### THE MOTION IS FOR:

- 1. An Order, substantially in the form attached hereto as Appendix 1:
  - (a) if necessary, abridging the time for service of the Notice of Motion such that the motion is properly returnable April 3, 2012 and dispensing with further service thereof;
  - (b) extending the Stay Period (the "Stay Period") as defined in paragraph 30 of the Initial Order of the Honourable Madam Justice Spivak dated February 22, 2012
     (the "Initial Order") and extended by the Order of the Honourable Madam
     Justice Spivak dated March 15, 2012, until June 15, 2012;

- (c) approving the Second Report of the Monitor (the "Second Report") provided by Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. in its capacity as monitor of the Applicants (the "Monitor") and the Monitor's activities as described therein; and
- (d) granting such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just.

### THE GROUNDS FOR THE MOTION ARE:

- 1. On February 22, 2012, the Court granted the Initial Order, which included a stay of proceedings as against the Arctic Glacier Parties (as defined in the Initial Order). The Stay Period was extended by Order of this Court on March 15, 2012. The Stay Period currently expires on April 5, 2012.
- 2. On March 16, 2012, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court granted an order recognizing these CCAA proceedings as a foreign main proceeding and enforcing the Initial Order in the United States on a final basis (the "US Recognition Order").
- 3. The Applicants have acted in good faith and with due diligence since the granting of the Initial Order, including that the Applicants have commenced the Sale and Investor Solicitation Process attached to the Initial Order (the "SISP") and have been working with the Monitor and the Financial Advisor and Chief Process Supervisor (as each term is defined in the Initial Order) in relation thereto.
- 4. The Applicants seek an extension of the Stay Period to June 15, 2012. This extension is necessary and appropriate in the circumstances, in particular to allow the Arctic Glacier Parties to continue to implement the SISP in accordance with the Initial Order.

- 5. The Applicants have sufficient liquidity to be able to continue operating in the ordinary course during the requested Stay Period.
- 6. The Monitor and the secured lenders are supportive of the requested extension of the Stay Period.
- 7. Section 11.02 and other provisions of the CCAA and the inherent and equitable jurisdiction of this Court.
- 8. Rules 2.03, 3.02 and 37.02(1) of the Court of Queen's Bench Rules, Manitoba Reg. 553/88. and
- 9. Such further and other grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.
