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## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 On August 13, 2024, in Supreme Court of British Columbia Action No. S-245481, Vancouver Registry (the “**CCAA Proceedings**”), the Supreme Court of British Columbia (the “**Court**”) granted Okanagan Growers Distribution Cooperative (formerly known as BC Tree Fruits Cooperative, “**BCTFC**”), BC Tree Fruits Industries Limited (“**BCTF Industries**”) and 0015755 B.C. Ltd. (formerly known as Growers Supply Company Limited, “**GSC**”, together with BCTFC and BCTF Industries, the “**BCTF Group**” or the “**Petitioners**”) an initial order (“**Initial Order**”) under the *Companies’ Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended. Among other things, the Initial Order granted the BCTF Group an initial stay of proceedings up to and including August 23, 2024, and appointed Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. (“**A&M**”) as the monitor of the BCTF Group (the “**Monitor**”) with enhanced powers.
- 1.2 During the CCAA Proceedings, this Honourable Court granted several orders authorizing the sale of substantially all of the BCTF Group’s real property and other assets. All of the transactions approved under these orders have now been completed.
- 1.3 On August 27, 2025, on the application of the Monitor, this Court granted two orders:
- a) an order (the “**Name Change and Claims Payment Order**”), among other things, authorizing the Monitor and Receiver to change the names of the BCTF Group and pay the claims (the “**Initial Accepted Claims**”) allowed by the Monitor as enumerated at Appendix B to the Fourteenth Report of the Monitor dated August 25, 2025 (the “**Fourteenth Report**”); and
  - b) an order (the “**Receivership Order**”), among other things: (i) discharging A&M as Monitor of the Petitioners; (ii) releasing and discharging the Monitor, counsel for the Monitor and each of their respective affiliates and officers, directors, partners, employees and agents (collectively, the “**Released Parties**”) from any and all claims that any person may have or be entitled to assert against the Released Parties; and (iii) appointing A&M as receiver (the “**Receiver**”), without security, of all of the assets, undertakings and property of the BCTF Group, including all proceeds thereof (the “**Receivership Proceedings**”), pursuant to section 39 of the *Law and Equity Act* (BC).
- 1.4 The Receivership Order further: (a) authorized the Monitor to make the payments contemplated under the Name Change and Claims Payment Order; and (b) expressly empowered and authorized the Receiver to carry out all of the duties of the Monitor under the Claims Process Order granted in the CCAA Proceedings on April 28, 2025 (the “**Claims Process Order**”).

- 1.5 On September 29, 2025, on the application of the Receiver, this Court granted an order (the “**Second Claims Payment Order**”) which, among other things, authorized and empowered the Receiver to pay the claims of additional claimants with Accepted Claims as enumerated in the Receiver’s report dated September 29, 2025 (the “**First Report**”).
- 1.6 Concurrently with filing this Second Report of the Receiver (the “**Second Report**”), the Receiver has filed an application seeking the following relief:
- a) an order (the “**Third Claims Payment Order**”), among other things: (i) authorizing and empowering it to pay the claims of those claimants whose claims have now been accepted by the Receiver since the granting of the Second Claims Payment Order (collectively, the “**Third Accepted Claims**”); (ii) approving the disallowance by the Monitor and Receiver, as applicable, of the Farming Karma Claim (as defined and described at paragraph 6.1 below); and (iii) authorizing the Receiver to deliver a Notice of Revision or Disallowance for any and all Claims in respect of Proof of Claims delivered to the Monitor pursuant to the Claims Process Order, but which have not been reviewed and adjudicated pursuant to paragraph 20 of the Claims Process Order;
  - b) an order, among other things, approving the activities of the Receiver, and approving the Monitor and Receiver’s fees and disbursements incurred between August 13, 2024 and February 28, 2026 (the “**Fee Period**”), as well as the fees of their legal counsel, Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP (“**Fasken**”) during the Fee Period; and
  - c) an order (the “**Member Distribution Determination Procedure Order**”) approving a process to determine the members and former members’ tree fruit delivery volume for the crop years 2018 to 2023 (the “**Member Distribution Determination Procedure**”).
- 1.7 Further information regarding the CCAA Proceedings and the Receivership Proceedings, including copies of all orders made in these proceedings and all affidavits, reports of the Monitor and Receiver, and other Court-filed documents and notices (other than anything filed under seal) (collectively, the “**Filed Materials**”) are available at [www.alvarezandmarsal.com/bctreefruits](http://www.alvarezandmarsal.com/bctreefruits) (the “**Receiver’s Website**”).

## **2.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 2.1 This Second Report has been prepared by the Receiver to provide information to this Honourable Court with information regarding the following matters:
- a) the name changes of BCTFC and GSC, and the proposed amendment to the style of cause of

- the Receivership Proceedings to reflect the new names of these Petitioners;
- b) the activities of the Receiver;
  - c) the status of the resolution of outstanding claims under the Claims Process Order;
  - d) the Third Accepted Claims;
  - e) the Farming Karma Claim;
  - f) the proposed extension of the deadline for the Receiver's issuance of a Notice of Revision or Disallowance under the Claims Process Order and, relatedly, the proposed treatment of one Claim which was inadvertently not adjudicated in accordance with the Claims Process Order;
  - g) the proposed treatment of select outstanding receivables;
  - h) the Monitor and Receiver's and Fasken's professional fees and disbursements;
  - i) the actual receipts and disbursements of the BCTF Group from August 18, 2025 to March 29, 2026 (the "**Reporting Period**"); and
  - j) the proposed Member Distribution Determination Procedure.

2.2 The Second Report should be read in conjunction with the Filed Materials found on the Receiver's Website. Background information contained in the Filed Materials has not been included herein to avoid unnecessary duplication. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Second Report have the meanings ascribed to them in the Filed Materials.

2.3 Unless otherwise stated, all monetary amounts contained in this Second Report are expressed in Canadian dollars.

### **3.0 ACTIVITIES OF THE RECEIVER**

3.1 Since Receiver's appointment on August 27, 2025 and up to and including the date of this Second Report, the Receiver's activities have included the following:

#### **Cash Flow Forecasts and Cash Flow Reporting**

- a) preparing of cash flow forecasts, including probable and hypothetical assumptions;
- b) reviewing invoices, making necessary payments and maintaining a ledger of cash receipts and disbursements;
- c) reviewing liquidity needs and purchasing Guaranteed Investment Certificates ("**GICs**") with funds held in trust;

#### **Claims Process**

- d) continuing with the administration of the Claims Process;
- e) corresponding with and providing information to Service Canada to assist in its review for Employment Insurance overpayments to former employees;
- f) engaging an external payroll service provider to calculate required withholding taxes for former employees with Proven Claims, and preparing 2026 T4s;
- g) administering distributions to creditors with Proven Claims in accordance with the Name Change and Claims Payment Order and the Second Claims Payment Order;

#### **Asset Realization Efforts**

- h) pursuing outstanding accounts receivable of BCTFC and GSC;
- i) reviewing the status of and continuing the civil claims initiated by BCTFC against various parties;

#### **Creditor and Other Stakeholder Matters**

- j) receiving and responding to numerous telephone and email inquiries from trade creditors, members, former members, employees and other interested parties;
- k) engaging in discussions with other stakeholders, including the current members' representative and the former members' representative, in respect of the *CCAA* Proceedings and related matters generally; and

#### **Other Matters**

- l) attending to the name changes of BCTFC and GSC;
- m) attending the hearing upon an application made by the former members of BCTFC on January 12, 2026;
- n) engaging tax accountants to prepare the Petitioners' tax returns for the fiscal years of 2025 and 2026; and
- o) developing the proposed Member Distribution Determination Procedure.

### **4.0 NAME CHANGE AND PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO STYLE OF CAUSE**

- 4.1 On July 24, 2025, the BCTF Group completed a transaction in which it sold substantially all of its remaining business assets (the "**Wildstone Transaction**"). One of the terms of the Wildstone Transaction included the requirement for the Monitor/Receiver to make an application to this Court to change the names of BCTFC and GSC to names that do not include "BC Tree Fruits", "Growers

Supply Company”, “BCTF” or “GSC” within 60 days of closing the Wildstone Transaction.

4.2 On August 27, 2025, this Court granted the Name Change and Claims Payment Order, authorizing the Monitor/Receiver to change the names of BCTFC and GSC.

4.3 On September 18, 2025, the name of GSC was changed to 0015755 B.C. Ltd. (“**001 B.C.**”), and on February 23, 2026, the name of BCTFC was changed to “Okanagan Growers Distribution Cooperative” (“**OGDC**”). Attached as Appendix “A” are copies of the Certificates of Name Change which have been filed with the BC Corporate Registry in respect of these name changes.

4.4 The Receiver proposes to amend the style of cause of the Receivership Proceedings to replace BCTFC and GSC with OGDC and 001 B.C., respectively, to reflect the name changes.

## **5.0 CLAIMS PROCESS UPDATE**

5.1 In the First Report the Receiver noted that, as at the date thereof, there remained five claims totaling \$1.72 million which were subject to a notice of dispute and which the Receiver was attempting to resolve (the “**Disputed Claims**”).

5.2 Since the First Report, two of the Disputed Claims have been resolved (being the Third Accepted Claims). The Third Accepted Claims are tabled below:

5.3 Accordingly, the Receiver seeks authorization from this Honourable Court to make payments to the claimants having the Third Accepted Claims totaling \$644,323.09.

5.4 As of the date of this report, there are three outstanding Disputed Claims remaining, as follows:

- 5.5 Of the remaining Disputed Claims, the Receiver is seeking an order approving the Monitor's disallowance of one such claim in full (being the Farming Karma Claim, as outlined further below).
- 5.6 The Receiver continues to work with the other two (2) claimants to resolve their Claim. In particular:
- a) the Receiver has scheduled an application before this Court to be heard May 14, 2026, for the adjudication of the Claim of Surjit S. Sandhu; and
  - b) the Receiver and Mangal Capital Inc. ("**Mangal**"), through their respective legal counsel, continue to be in discussions regarding a litigation plan, with a view of bringing an application before this Court in or around June 2026 for the adjudication of Mangal's Claim.

### **Employee Claims**

- 5.7 As noted in the First Report, on September 6, 2025, the Receiver provided the list of the accepted employee claim amounts to Service Canada for review for any potential overpayment on Employment Insurance ("EI"). Service Canada completed its review on January 29, 2026, and the Receiver has subsequently made distributions to former employees with Proven Claims, after taking into account any EI overpayments, amounts subrogated under the Wage Earner Protection Program, and withholding taxes.

### **Canada Revenue Agency**

- 5.8 On June 16, 2025, the Canada Revenue Agency (the "**CRA**") filed an unsecured claim under the Claims Process against GSC and BCTFC, with the GSC component consisting of a claim in the amount of \$528,735.61 (the "**CRA GSC Claim**").
- 5.9 The CRA GSC Claim was assessed by the CRA for the reversal of GST input tax credits claimed by GSC prior to the CCAA Proceedings, with the assumption that creditor claims would be unpaid under the CCAA Proceedings. The CRA GSC Claim amount appeared to have been calculated based on the initial creditors' listing provided published by the Monitor on the Monitor's Website.
- 5.10 On June 26, 2025, the Monitor issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance which disallowed the CRA GSC Claim entirely, on the basis that all of GSC's creditors would be receiving distributions that would satisfy all unpaid amounts.
- 5.11 On November 17, 2025, the Receiver received a letter from the CRA reassessing its previous assessment and decreasing its claim to \$303,656.55.
- 5.12 On January 5, 2026, the Receiver sent an email to the Department of Justice, providing documentation to show that all creditor claims against GSC had been paid in full.

5.13 On February 2, 2026, the Receiver received a letter from the CRA confirming that it had revised its previous assessments and reduced its assessment (and therefore the CRA GSC Claim) to \$0.00.

## **6.0 FARMING KARMA CLAIM**

6.1 On May 29, 2025, Farming Karma Fruit Company Ltd. ("**Farming Karma**") filed an unsecured claim against BCTFC in the amount of \$16,320.00 (the "**Farming Karma Claim**"). Attached hereto as Appendix "B" is a copy of the Proof of Claim filed by Farming Karma.

6.2 Farming Karma alleged that a \$16,320.00 deposit was paid to BCTFC for 102 bins at a rate of \$160.00 per bin, and that the deposit was not returned by BCTFC despite Farming Karma returning the bins. However, Farming Karma did not provide any evidence that the bins were returned, and BCTFC's records do not contain any evidence of the bins being returned.

6.3 On June 6, 2025, the Monitor issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance (the "**Farming Karma NORD**") which disallowed the Farming Karma Claim in its entirety. The Farming Karma NORD included evidence from BCTFC's bin inventory system showing that a total of 102 bins remained outstanding from two specific invoices. Attached hereto as Appendix "C" is a copy of the Farming Karma NORD.

6.4 On July 11, 2025, Farming Karma filed a Notice of Dispute (the "**Farming Karma NOD**") with the Monitor alleging that BCTFC's records were incorrect, but Farming Karma failed to provide any evidence to refute the BCTFC's records. Attached hereto as Appendix "D" is a copy of the Farming Karma NOD.

6.5 On August 28, 2025, the Receiver informed Farming Karma, by email, that the Farming Karma NOD was being rejected on the basis that the claimant has not provided evidence that the bins were returned. The Receiver also requested confirmation from Farming Karma that it accepted the Receiver's adjudication by September 18, 2025. Attached hereto as Appendix "E" is a copy of the referenced email correspondence.

6.6 On September 18, September 22, and October 7, 2025, the Receiver emailed Farming Karma to request confirmation that the Monitor/Receiver's adjudication had been accepted, but the Receiver did not receive any response. Attached hereto as Appendix "F" are copies of the referenced email correspondence.

6.7 On October 7, 2025, a representative of the Receiver called Avi Gill, Chief Executive Officer of Farming Karma, and was advised verbally that Farming Karma would not be pursuing its Claim any further.

6.8 Based on the above, and particularly as Farming Karma has not confirmed in writing that it will not be pursuing its Claim, the Receiver is requesting that this Honourable Court approve the Monitor's adjudication and disallow this Claim.

#### **7.0 OMITTED CLAIM TO BE ADJUDICATED**

7.1 On September 18, 2025, a claimant contacted the Receiver with respect to a Proof of Claim in the amount of \$50,000.00 that was submitted but was not included in the Initial Accepted Claims (the "Omitted Claim").

7.2 Upon review, the Receiver determined that the Omitted Claim was received from Karmjit and Balvir Gill on May 29, 2025 but was inadvertently overlooked during the Monitor's review and adjudication of Claims.

7.3 Pursuant to paragraph 20 of the Claims Process Order, if the Monitor does not send a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to a Claimant within 20 days after the Business Day on which the Monitor is deemed to have received the Proof of Claim, or by June 27, 2025, whichever is later, the Claim shall be deemed to have been accepted in the amount submitted.

7.4 Based on information available and upon adjudication by the Receiver, it is the Receiver's view that the Omitted Claim should not be accepted in the amount filed. As such, the Receiver is seeking the approval of this Honourable Court to extend the deadline for the Receiver's issuance of a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to enable the Receiver to issue a NORD at \$36,884.61.

7.5 The Receiver has advised the claimant of its intention to revise their claim to \$36,884.61, and the claimant has verbally agreed to the proposed plan of action.

#### **8.0 APPLICATIONS FOR ORDERS IN RESPECT OF OUTSTANDING RECEIVABLES**

8.1 The BCTFC (now OGDC) has five significant outstanding accounts owing to it from five debtors, totaling \$922,367.42, as follows:

- a) Sunny Valley - \$322,568: the Receiver has filed a Notice of Civil Claim in respect of the indebtedness owing by Sunney Valley. To date, Sunny Valley has not provided its List of Documents in accordance with the *Supreme Court Civil Rules* of British Columbia, and the Receiver anticipates an application in that proceeding may be necessary to move the matter toward resolution;
- b) Crazy Cherry Fruit Company - \$233,440.77
- c) Smagh & Sons Ltd. - \$173,008.28
- d) Secrest Organic Product Ltd. - \$101,905.17

e) Bridgeway Brokerage - \$91,445.20

8.2 The Receiver expects to bring applications against these debtors in these proceedings or otherwise for orders that the above-named debtors pay their outstanding accounts to the Receiver forthwith.

## 9.0 PROFESSIONAL FEES

9.1 Summarized in the table below are the professional fees and disbursements of the Monitor/Receiver and its legal counsel, Fasken, during the Fee Period. Detailed statements of account of the Monitor/Receiver and Fasken are included in affidavits to be filed by the respective representatives of the Monitor/Receiver and Fasken concurrently with this Second Report (the “Fee Affidavits”). This section should be read in conjunction with the Fee Affidavits.

9.2 A summary of the Monitor’s professional fees and disbursements for the period ending August 31, 2025, which totals \$2,024,763.64 (the “Monitor’s Fees”) is set out at paragraph 4 of the Affidavit of Anthony Tillman, sworn on April 1, 2026 (the “Tillman Affidavit”). The Monitor’s Fees consist of professional services fees in the amount of \$1,904,673.00, disbursements in the amount of \$23,673.30 and applicable taxes in the amount of \$96,417.34.

9.3 A summary of the Monitor’s professional fees indicating name, title, hourly rate and hours charged by the Monitor’s professional staff and details of its out-of-pocket disbursements for the period ending August 31, 2025 is set out at paragraph 7 of the Tillman Affidavit.

9.4 A summary of the Receiver’s professional fees and disbursements for the period ending February 28, 2026, which totals \$361,368.82 (the “Receiver’s Fees”) is set out at paragraph 11 of the Tillman Affidavit. The Receiver’s Fees consist of professional services fees in the amount of \$342,321.50, disbursements in the amount of \$1,839.28 and applicable taxes in the amount of \$17,208.04.

9.5 A summary of the Receiver’s professional fees indicating name, title, hourly rate and hours charged

by the Receiver's professional staff and details of its out-of-pocket disbursements for the period ending February 28, 2026 is set out at paragraph 14 of the Tillman Affidavit.

- 9.6 A summary of the professional fees of the Monitor and Receiver's legal counsel, Fasken, for the Fee Period, which totals \$1,171,544.33, including out-of-pocket disbursements of \$18,437.50 and applicable taxes of \$124,132.83 ("**Fasken's Fees**"), is set out at paragraph 3 of the Affidavit of Kibben Jackson, affirmed on April 1, 2026 ("**Jackson Affidavit**").
- 9.7 A summary of Fasken's professional fees indicating name, title, hourly rate and hours charged by Fasken's professional staff and details of its out-of-pocket disbursements for the Fee Period is set out at paragraph 8 of the Jackson Affidavit.
- 9.8 The Receiver considers the professional fees and disbursements charged by Fasken to have been necessarily incurred and that the hours and hourly rates charged are fair and reasonable given the circumstances.

**10.0 RECEIVER'S INTERIM STATEMENT OF CASH RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED MARCH 29, 2026**

- 10.2 The BCTF Group experienced net cash outflows of \$18.9 million during the Reporting Period, primarily comprised of the following items:
- a) accounts receivable collections pursued by the Receiver and a debt collection agency, refunds for credits and pre-paid services, and other receipts totaling \$598,000;
  - b) release of funds held in escrow totaling \$294,000 to be utilized for the termination of BCTF Group management;
  - c) disbursements for payroll, benefits, independent contractor payments, the release of amounts held in escrow for BCTF Group management, and withholding taxes totaled \$307,000;
  - d) disbursements to the BCTF Group board of directors and for insurance totaled \$42,000. Payments to the BCTF Group board of directors ceased following the commencement of the Receivership Proceedings;
  - e) utilities, telephone and internet payments totaled \$7,000 for the Reporting Period;
  - f) other general and administrative costs were \$314,000 and consisted of tax preparation fees, document storage and management fees, as well as a \$121,000 payment for cancellation

- charges for telecom and internet services;
- g) professional fees, including payments to the Receiver, Fasken, Norton Rose Fulbright Canada LLP, counsel for the current members' representative and counsel for the former members' representative totaled \$1.0 million; and
  - h) distributions to unsecured creditors (cash) as outlined in the Name Change and Claims Payment Order and the Second Claims Payment Order totaled \$18.1 million.
- 10.3 As at March 29, 2026, the Receiver's trust accounts held a combined total of \$14.6 million in cash and guaranteed investment certificates, after accounting for \$2.2 million in uncashed distribution cheques and \$2.5 million of payments to Service Canada and the Receiver General in relation to the employee claims that have not been processed.

## **11.0 MEMBER DISTRIBUTION DETERMINATION PROCEDURE**

- 11.1 On January 12, 2026, this Court heard an application by the former members of BCTFC (the "**Former Members**") to prevent the current members of BCTFC (the "**Current Members**") from holding a special general meeting to consider and vote upon a proposed special resolution amending Rule 125 of the *BC Tree Fruits Cooperative Rules*, as revised November 16, 2021 (the "**Co-Op Rules**") that would prevent the disposition of any remaining assets of BCTFC to Former Members.
- 11.2 On February 12, 2026, Justice Gropper delivered her Reasons for Judgment (the "**Judgment**"), which ordered that:
- a) the directors of BCTFC be prohibited and restrained from convening a special general meeting to consider the proposed special resolution; and
  - b) the Receiver is to comply with the existing *Co-Op Rules* in making any future distribution of surplus funds to current and former members.
- 11.3 Based on the Judgment, the Receiver has developed a process to ascertain tree fruit delivery volume of each Current Member and Former Member (collectively, the "**Members**" and each a "**Member**") in accordance with Rule 125 of the *Co-Op Rules*, which governs the distribution of surplus funds.
- 11.4 Rule 125 provides that in the event BCTFC permanently ceases operations, surplus funds are to be dealt with as follows:

### ***125. Distribution of surplus in final year of operations***

*After setting aside the amount required as a reserve and paying any dividend permitted by these Rules, the Association must, but only in the year in which it intends to permanently cease*

*operations, distribute the whole of its then accumulated surplus, including all amounts realized from the sale or other disposition of its assets (but after setting aside an amount equal to the aggregate paid up capital of all its outstanding shares), to the members and former members of the Association (including the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns) in the same proportion that the tonnage of tree fruits accepted by the Association from each of them (or from the grower through whom the member or former member derives or derived membership) in the previous 6 years bears to the total tonnage of tree fruits accepted by the Association from all its growers during those same 6 years.*

- 11.5 As noted in the Thirteenth Report of the Monitor dated July 9, 2025, the Monitor had previously proposed to interpret the “6 years” period referenced in Rule 125 to be the period 2018 to 2023, as 2023 was the last full year BCTFC accepted fruit deliveries.
- 11.6 In consultation with the former VP of corporate development of BCTFC, the Receiver has since refined the period for the determination of delivery volume to be from June 1, 2018 to May 31, 2024. This is because, in the ordinary course, BFTFC received deliveries for a particular “crop year” between June 1 and May 31. Accordingly, the Receiver proposes to interpret the “6 years” period in a manner which corresponds to the *crop* years 2018 to 2023.
- 11.7 Upon the publication of the Judgment, the Receiver has been contacted by numerous growers to inquire as to their eligibility to receive a distribution from any surplus funds. The Receiver was made aware that there is a list being circulated among the grower/member group that provides a dollar amount of each person’s potential entitlement, and notes that the list was not prepared by the Receiver. To date, distribution amounts have not been ascertained.
- 11.8 Further, the Receiver has also been made aware that there may be some confusion with the definition of “grower” or “member” of BCTFC, and therefore confusion as to entitlement to a distribution from any surplus funds. To be eligible for a distribution under Rule 125, a person must have been an active member of BCTFC (and not just a grower) at the time the fruit was delivered. Having a grower number *does not* automatically provide membership to the cooperative. A list of current and former members who, according to the records of the BCTFC, delivered tree fruits from the crop years 2018 – 2023 (and were active members during such time) is attached hereto as Appendix “G”.

#### **Member Distribution Determination Procedure**

- 11.9 Capitalized terms not defined in this section shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the draft Member Distribution Determination Procedure Order.

11.10 The Member Distribution Determination Procedure is a “negative notice” process through which the Monitor will notify each Member of the amount of their Delivery Amount according to the books and records of the Petitioners by issuing a Delivery Assessment Notice. A Member may: (i) accept the Delivery Amount attributed to them by taking no action by the Delivery Reporting Deadline; or (ii) dispute their Delivery Amount by signing and delivering a Member Declaration to the Receiver by the Delivery Reporting Deadline. Any other Person who wishes to assert a Delivery Amount may sign and deliver a Member Declaration to the Receiver.

11.11 Key steps and timelines described in the proposed Member Distribution Determination Procedure Order are summarized in the table below:

- 11.12 Upon receipt of a Dispute Notice and Adjudication Application, the Receiver may attempt to consensually resolve the dispute regarding the Delivery Amount, failing which the Adjudication Application will be heard and determined by Court by the Adjudication Hearing Deadline.
- 11.13 The purpose of the Member Distribution Determination Procedure is to determine the Delivery Amounts for each of the Members, which is required to calculate the *pro rata* entitlement of each Member to any surplus funds as stipulated under Rule 125, and form the basis for a later application for an order authorizing distributions to such Members. Proposed distributions may be impacted by setoff claims for amounts owing to the Petitioners by certain Members.
- 11.14 The Receiver’s observations in relation to the proposed Member Distribution Determination Procedure are as follows:
- a) the Petitioners have maintained their accounting records prior to and throughout the CCAA Proceedings and the Receivership Proceedings. Historically, Members (and growers) typically rely on the Petitioners to record the amounts owed to them as those are recorded in the Petitioners’ database and reported to Members (and growers) periodically. Therefore, the Receiver believes that the use of a “negative notice” process is appropriate in the circumstances; and
  - b) the Receiver is of the view that the proposed Member Distribution Determination Procedure provides reasonable timelines for Members to verify and, if necessary, prove their Delivery Amounts, for the Receiver to adjudicate the asserted Delivery Amounts and for the dispute

resolution process to be carried out by the Receiver and ultimately, by this Honourable Court if any claims cannot be resolved consensually.

11.15 The Receiver is of the view that the Member Distribution Determination Procedure should be initiated at this time to confirm the Delivery Amounts, calculate the anticipated distributions pursuant to Rule 125 and, ultimately, seek authorization from this Court to make distributions to eligible Members.

## 12.0 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

12.1 The Receiver respectfully recommends that this Honourable Court:


- a) approve and authorize the Receiver to pay the Third Accepted Claims;
- b) approve the Monitor's adjudication of the Farming Karma Claim and disallow the Farming Karma Claim;
- c) extend the deadline for the Receiver to deliver Notices of Revision or Disallowance under the Claims Process Order, including with respect to the Omitted Claim;
- d) approve the proposed amendment to the style of cause of the within proceedings to reflect the new names of the Petitioners;
- e) approve the activities of the Receiver;
- f) approve the professional fees and disbursements of the Monitor and Receiver, and those of their legal counsel; and
- g) grant the Member Distribution Determination Procedure Order.

On the return invoice 0220105, you can see that the return was a Reverse Action. For reference, the return invoice 0222124 having been a true return has nothing in the "Reverse Action" column. This shows that errors had to be caught by Avi Gill and BC Tree Fruits logs weren't always reliable.
