ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:

- [1] All defined terms used in this Endorsement shall, unless otherwise defined, have the meanings ascribed to them in the Factum of the Applicants dated January 20, 2026. All factual references in this Endorsement are from the Fourth Report of the Monitor dated January 16, 2026.
- [2] The Applicants seek a further Stay Extension Order extending the current Stay Period (that expires on January 31, 2026) to January 29, 2027. The motion is unopposed and is supported by the Monitor.
- [3] The business has been liquidated and is in wind-down mode. The Applicants, working with the Monitor, are continuing to pursue the ERC Tax Refunds, obtain the release of funds under existing letters of credit, collecting remaining accounts receivable, and communicate with stakeholders.
- [4] I am satisfied that the Stay Extension Order should be granted pursuant to s. 11.02 of the CCAA to enable the Applicants to pursue these remaining activities for the benefit of stakeholders. The Applicants are acting in good faith and with due diligence, the Monitor believes that the extension will not materially prejudice any creditors, and the funds held by the Applicants and the Monitor are expected to provide sufficient liquidity to cover expenses during the extension period.
- [5] Stay Extension Order to go as signed by me and attached to this Endorsement. This order is effective from today's date and is enforceable without the need for entry and filing.
