The extensive materials filed in support of this motion to approve the fees and disbursements of Alvarez & Marsal and Goodmans LLP have been posted to the A&M Website. No objections or adverse comment was received in respect of the requested relief.

Counsel to the Monitor advised that an interim dividend in the amount of \$0.55 has been paid and that it is projected that the final dividend will be in the range of \$0.75, subject to finalization of the pharmacists claims.

Details in respect of the Target Entities have been documented in previous endorsements, including the Sanction Hearing.

The requested amounts are fully supported by detailed dockets and summaries. It is noted that a portion of the A&M fees are in U.S. dollars, reflecting services provided in the U.S. by U.S.

personnel of A&M. I am satisfied that, in the circumstances, the requested fees and disbursements of both A&M and its counsel are reasonable and they are approved.
