The motion was not opposed and was supported by the Monitor. I am satisfied that the Applicants continue to act in good faith and with due diligence in this CCAA proceeding.

The Applicant requests an extension of the Stay Period to January 26, 2018 in order to complete outstanding matters. In particular 3 areas require attention:

1. Resolution of CRA Claims;
2. Distribution of remaining funds to Creditors;

3. Winding-up of technical and administrative issues.

I am satisfied that the request to extend the Stay Period to January 26, 2018 is reasonable in the circumstances.

Discharge of Employee Representative Counsel and Representatives also granted.
